

Hug You Shawl

Materials:

Yarn:

1 x Scheepjes Whirligig (20% Alpaca, 80% Virgin Wool; 450 g/1000 m).

The shawl on the first page is made with the color 203, Teal to Yellow, starting from the (teal) outside of the skein.

Hook: Tunisian crochet hook 7.0 mm with an approx. 60 cm cord.

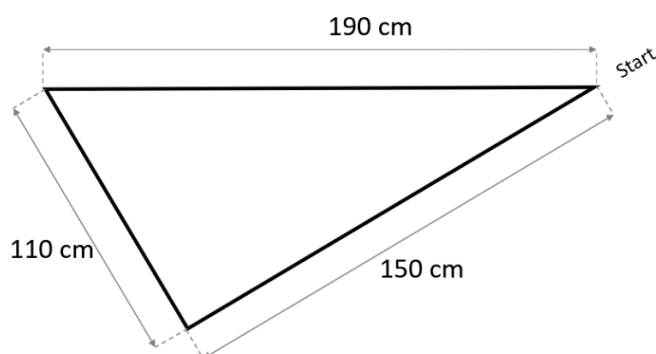
Tapestry needle

Scissors

Size and shape:

This shawl has the shape of an asymmetric triangle and is crocheted in rows from one side to the other with the yarn Scheepjes Whirligig. You can easily adjust the size of the shawl by reducing or increasing the number of rows.

If you use the same yarn and hook suggested in this pattern, the shawl will measure approx. 190 x 150 x 110 cm.



Abbreviations (US terms):

St – stitch

Ss – slip stitch

Ch – chain

Tfs – tunisian full stitch

Tss – tunisian simple stitch

Ttops – tunisian top stitch

Ls – last stitch: insert the hook under both loops of the last stitch of previous row, yo and pull through.

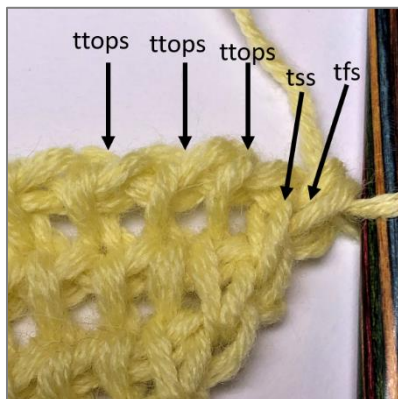
FP – forward pass

RP – return pass

Yo – yarn over

Increases in this pattern:

The increases in this pattern is made by making one **tfs** stitch each forward row **between** the first and second stitch.



Pattern notes:

- It is easier to crochet a neat start/point of the shawl, if you use a smaller hook when crocheting the first few rows.
 - Stitches between () are repeated as many times as indicated after the parentheses.
 - Stitches between | | shows how many stitches you should have after completing the row.
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Pattern:

Foundation row:

FP: Ch2, 1 foundation row st in the second ch from your hook (2 loops on the hook).

RP: Ch1, yo, pull through 2 loops on hook.

Row 1:

FP: Tfs, ls.

RP: Ch1, (yo, pull through 2 loops on hook) across until 1 loop remains on hook.

|3 sts|

Row 2:

FP: Tfs, tss, ls.

RP: Ch1, (yo, pull through 2 loops on hook) across until 1 loop remains on hook.

|4 sts|

Row 3:

FP: Tfs, tss, (ttops) until end of row, ls.

RP: Ch1, (yo, pull through 2 loops on hook) across until 1 loop remains on hook.

Repeat row 3 until the shawl has the size you like, then continue with the last row.
I made a total of 175 rows.

Stitch count following rows:

Each row increases by 1 stitch.

Last row:

FP: Repeat row 3 and bind off.

RP: There is no reverse pass.

I used slip stitches to bind off, if you prefer to bind off with single crochets you can do that too.

Cut yarn and weave in ends.
